FreeTalky: Don't Be Afraid!

Conversations Made Easier by a Humanoid Robot using Persona-based Dialogue



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Overview

Xenoglossphobia

- Foreign language anxiety; a consistent and irrational fear revolving around foreign languages
- Exposure therapy with FreeTalky NAO robot replaces the human to relieve the anxiety of the user

Main Modules


- Speech recognition
- Persona-based dialogue system
- English grammar error correction
- Humanoid robot

Contribution

- Propose FreeTalky, where users can receive feedback on English grammar errors and improve their English conversation skills
- Content of multi-turn conversations can be adaptively altered to suit the users and provide diverse conversational experience to the users with a persona dialogue system
- Possible to alleviate the psychological pressure experienced by people suffering from xenoglossphobia using the NAO robot


FreeTalky

Process



- 1. User sets the persona of the robot
- 2. The user begins conversation with the robot
- 3. The input of the user is converted into text (STT) and passed to the dialogue system
- 4. The dialogue model generates a response given previous history and the persona sentences
- 5. Generated response is converted into speech (TTS) and the robot speaks the response
- 6. After the conversation, the robot provides grammar error feedback with the GEC system

Grammar Error Correction System


Qualitative Analysis




Satisfaction Survey

Response to the survey



- Most questions about the system were scored as strongly agree or agree
- Implies that the proposed system is suitable for alleviating people's xenoglossphobia
 - Shows a positive correlation in all question relationships
