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Explicit identity in interactive discourse



- Impression management: we strategically present ourselves to others to achieve socially and rhetorically desirable goals (Goffman, 1959)
- Demographic parameters: intentionally communicated to create/manage our own social identities, impacting

(Gumperz, 1982)

- role of the speaker
- expectations and standards of the audience
- subsequent discourse dynamics

Argumentative success is contingent upon the way arguers manage and project their identities (Kline, 1987)

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► Consequence → vulnerability

 property is now open to rebuttal, scrutiny, and even bias in the discourse (Sap et al., 2020; De Candia et al., 2022)

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Research Gap:

- Lack of relevant datasets on the effects of gender and demographic properties explicitly noted by author/community
- Limited analysis on how inclusion of explicit demographics in online argument forums impacts discourse
- Current author gender annotations rely on induced methods (e.g. first names or profile pictures), neglecting the social nature of gender and overlooking the impact of self-disclosures

Investigate self-disclosures of **author gender** and their influence on interaction dynamics in an online persuasion forum

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RQ1 When do people disclose their gender?

 distribution of gender self-disclosures across automatically extracted topics

RQ2 How does the forum community react to gender disclosures?

RQ3 What are the stylistic features of posts with self-disclosures, and how do they impact the forum community?

- analysis of the modulation of forum activity (votes, replies, community distribution) triggered by the self-disclosures

- RQ3 What are the stylistic features of posts with self-disclosures, and how do they impact the forum community?
 - integrate linguistic (i.e., readability metrics, relative frequency of POS tags) and pragmatic (i.e., toxicity, sentiment) features

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

Explicit Gender Disclosures


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- Two human annotators
 - quoted speech: They don't want to hear 'I'm nonbinary'
 - hypothetical situations: If I am <u>female</u>


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


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- Race-related topic: co-occurrence pattern with gender report, e.g. "as an Asian woman", "I am a white man".

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- Topics relate to gender or situations in which the set of experiencers is unbalanced
- Race-related topic: co-occurrence pattern with gender report, e.g. "as an Asian woman", "I am a white man".
- All topics addressed by males and females

RQ1: When Do People Explicitly Mention their Gender?

Establishing the speaker's credibility (Falk and Lapesa, 2022)

CMV: If I was raped or sexually assaulted I probably wouldn't report it. Preface: I'm a 23 year old <u>woman</u>. I believe that my life would be far worse off (...)



(Habernal and Gurevych, 2017)

I think that feminism currently uses hate speech as a way to advance its goals. In fact, this attitude hurts the advancement of women. CMV

I'll start by saying I'm 26 male. (...)

A combination of a credibility with a concession (Musi, 2018)

CMV: I think the feminist movement was detrimental to society.

Firstly I'd just like to point out that I am <u>female</u>. Secondly I'd like to clarify that I'm all for equality between all people. However, (...)

RQ2: How do these mentions influence the community?

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
Regression models:


- Consider CMVGENDER and SCORE as dependent variables
- Independent variables:
 - type of interaction (i.e. quantity and degree of post appreciation)
 - community composition (i.e. amount of males and/or females in the comment community)


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- Step-wise model selection via AIC
 - CMVGENDER Pseudo $R^2 = 52\%$; score $R^2 = 64\%$
 - Report standardized beta values for significant (Pr(|z|) < 0.05) terms









Explicit mentions strongly define the commenting population

Note: this is not a feature of the model for EXTCMVGENDER




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
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




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
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- Argument-counterargument discourse

comments scores are strong predictors for post score





- comments scores are strong predictors for post score


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Explicitly mentioning gender has a persuasive function

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 - comments from users of the same gender
 - explicit gender mentions from users of the opposite gender
 - revealing gender identity in argument *lowers* the rating of the post
- Gender-related style differences
 - a style that is more frequent for one gender, such as overt expressions of personal or empathetic qualities, has a similar community impact as explicit mentions of gender

Contributions and Next Steps

New layers of features for CMV_T

- allowing for evaluating demographic, stylistic, and interactive properties in an online setting
- serve to better understand biases in AM (Spliethöver and Wachsmuth, 2020) and assessing Argument Quality

Extended use of CMVGENDER annotations

- support collecting terms and attributes for explicit bias identification and removal (Barikeri et al., 2021; Holtermann et al., 2022)
- provides a ground-truth to anchor studies on moral foundations (Alshomary et al., 2022) and human values (Kiesel et al., 2022)
